- Desire to engage in education
- Achievement indicative of best effort and interest
- Outstanding achievement in a learning area
- Success at activity outside of the usual curriculum

Students should consider providing the following to support their application for scholarship:

- Previous school reports
- References
- Certificates from competitions such as (but not limited to) UNSW educational assessment Australia ICAS, National Geographic Channel Geography Competition, Australian History Competition
- Awards such as Australia Day Citizenship Award, Duke of Edinburgh Award, club or organisation role or award.
- Course reports
- Statement of community engagement such as (but not limited to) involvement in volunteer work, charity, and fund raising.
